Limassol is geographically situated on the southern coast of Cyprus. It is the largest city of Cyprus in geographical size. The district of Limassol is bordered by the district of Larnaka in the east, the district of Pafos in the west, the capital; Nicosia in the north, with Akrotiri Bay to the south. Limassol's central position offers easy access to all major cities as well as Troodos Mountains within a 35 to 45 minute drive. It is also conveniently situated only 35 minutes away from both Larnaka and Pafos airports.

Limassol is a safe destination which has much to share, with its beautiful seafronts, countless cultural, recreational and leisure activities, vibrant events and festivals, as well as being a centre for conferences and incentive travel programmes.

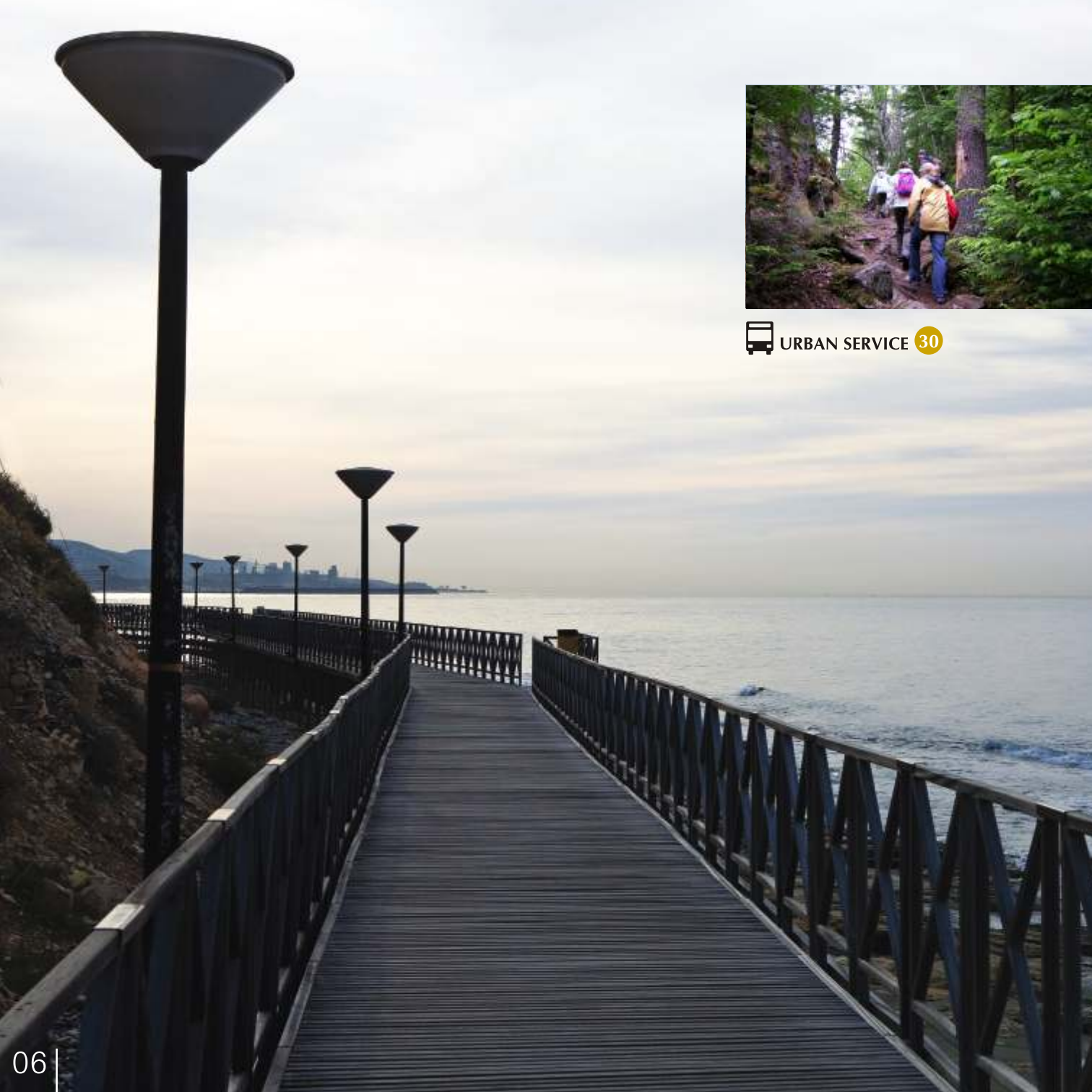

Highlights of the tour: Prophet Elias Monastery excavations (5th cent. A.D.), Agia Christina Church dating to the 12th cent. A.D., the recently restored old village house the Cultural Centre which is the 'get together centre' of the inhabitants of Germasogeia, Agia Paraskevi Church built at the end of the 19th cent, artist's workshop, water dam of Germasogeia.

Discover the Natural Environment of Germasogeia* (Oct-Apr)

Guided bus and walking tour

Highlights of the tour: the tour drives below the hills and escarpments on either side of the valley made up of sedimentary rocks. Koryphi is one of them with a height of 382 meters above sea

level. The tour goes along the valley to the tranquil area of Pinicaria. Includes half an hour's walk (there is uphill walking) along the nature trail of the area laid out by the Forestry Department and the magnificent view of the water dam and river. The ruins of water mills can be seen on the bank of the river.

Hiking Nature Trails

Limassol's multifaceted scenery and climate makes for an ideal walking paradise. Many nature trails offer spectacular views of lush vineyards, plantations, olive groves, the beautiful coast, traditional and quaint villages, churches & monasteries and colourful paths which boast the rich and varied flora that Cyprus is recognized for. Special hiking excursions can be organized by the Sightseeing Tour Operators.

It is circular trail and its length is 1,5km. Time 45 minutes. Machairas

National Forest Park: 'Mantra tou Kampiou'.

It is circular trail and its length is 1 km. Time 30 minutes.

With very few winter months, the Cyprus climate is ideal for cyclists. There are many bicycle paths throughout Limassol, especially along the seafront stretch. Set routes also offer a refreshing and healthy way to explore the area. While viewing the sea, colourful landscapes or mountainous regions, the challenging variety of terrains make each course a unique experience. 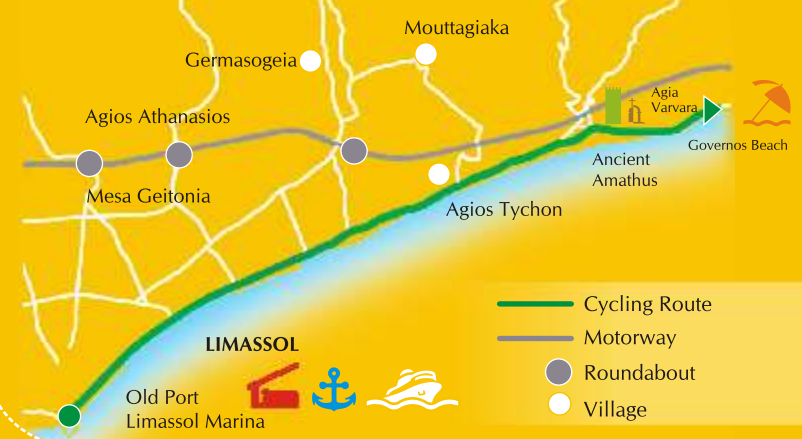
1 Limassol Pano Platres Cycling Route (Signposted route)

Road conditions: This is an asphalt track surface route. Few parts of the asphalt track surface are not in good condition.
Start point: Limassol Marina (Limassol), 0 metre
End point: Pano Platres, 1200 metres
Points of Interest: Kolossi Castle, Vouni, Koilani, Ayia Mavri, Myllomeri Waterfalls
Viewpoints: There is a sign-posted viewpoint and resting place along this part of the route

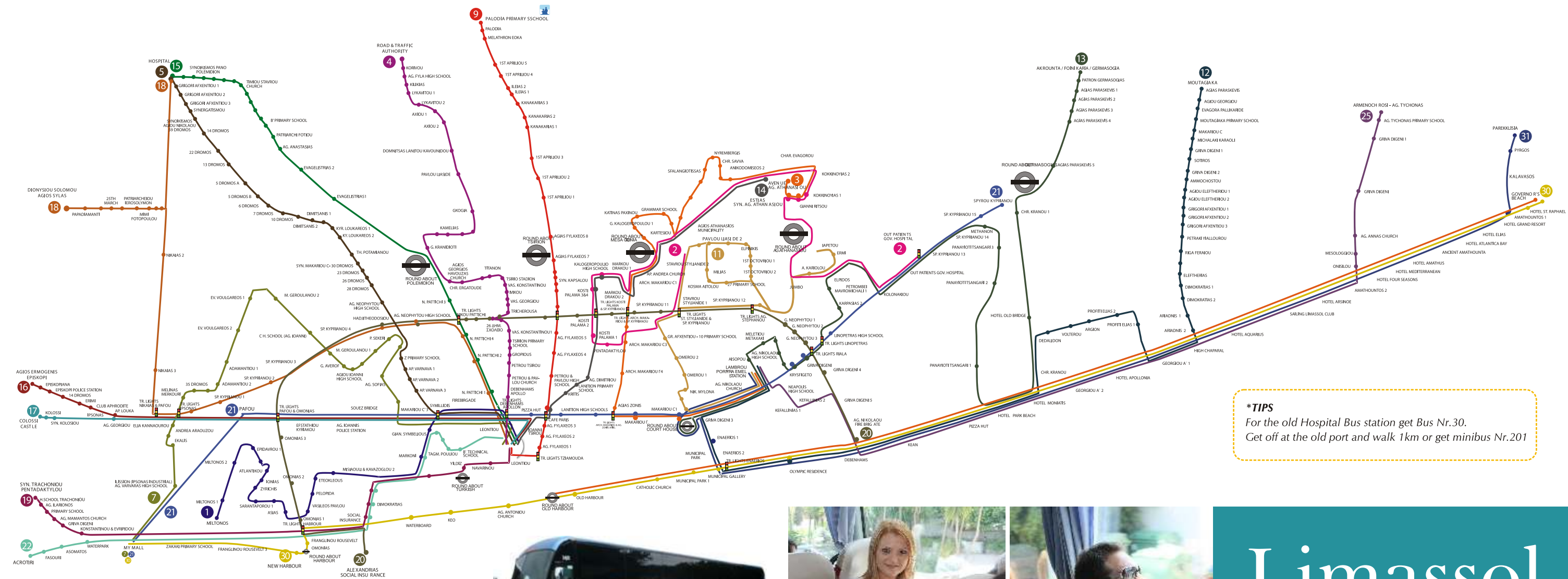

Dasoudi Beach

Is located in the heart of the Limassol tourist area. Its forest area and extra facilities such as small playground, restaurant, beach volley area, Olympic Swimming pool, make it a popular beach location in town.

Bus Nr 30.

Lady's Mile

located on the west part of Limassol, is an 8km stretch with mostly unspoiled sandy beaches with shallow waters and necessary facilities, suitable for families.

Bus Nr 30. / Get off at the Port of Limassol and 10 minutes walk.

Further south of Lady's Mile is an unspoiled area, the **Button Beach**, where small coastal sand dunes have grown. The Holy Monastery of St. Nicholas of the Cats built in 3 65 is located nearby

Bus Nr 30. / Get off at the Port of Limassol and walk.

Episkopi and Avdimou

are more relaxing settings. Avdimou is sandy and shallow; suitable for children.

Kourion Beach

is in Episkopi, approximately 17 km from Limassol. Its location is well known as a main archeological site the ancient Greco Roman Kourion theatre is only a short distance away. The beach is mostly sand and pebbles and the waters are suitable for windsurfing.

Melanda Beach

is found near Avdimou. Backed by amazing red sandstone cliffs, it is mostly sand and pebble with lots of seaweed. The facilities are limited in the area but it offers excellent swimming once passed the pebbles.

Pissouri beach/bay

30 km west of Limassol (midway between Limassol and Pafos), is more developed with hills and cliffs on both sides creating a beautiful and serene spot. It is mainly sandy but has shingles and pebbles in the middle.

Governor's Beach

Midway between Larnaka and Limassol is Governor's Beach. The tranquil setting has shallow crystal waters and a sandy beach ideal for families with children. The white rocks area is an ideal spot for snorkeling. Generally, this location offers much for nature lovers including pleasant walks following the nature trails in the nearby hills.

Visitors can become familiar with yet another aspect of Cyprus civilization by discovering churches and monasteries of the former Byzantine Empire. There are several routes in Limassol including one on Troodos with its ten richly decorated churches and monasteries. UNESCO, an agency of the United Nations whose primary aim is to identify and conserve sites whose outstanding values should be preserved for all humanity, have placed these 10 locations on the World Heritage List. There are four religious routes throughout Limassol.

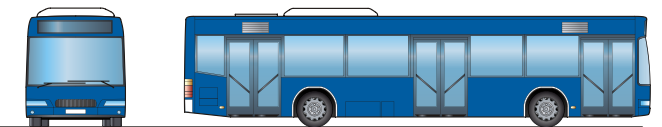

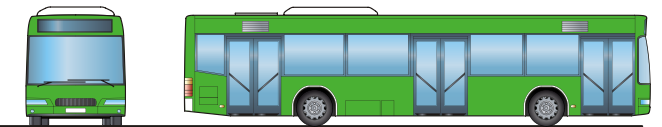
