



A double rock cliff that looks like a moray fish, like a monstrous form in the center of the village. This is how it is described by researchers who have proven that energy flux runs through it. Some also believe that this is where Atlantis was. From satellite images, its diamond shape looks like the Taurus constellation.

## **2** Troullorotsos

From studies of vital energy invisible electromagnetic channels, that go through earth on important buildings such as the Parthenon, the Great Pyramid and others, one such was identified in Cyprus. It can be found on the Kornos - Delikipos road. Studies refer to abundant positive cosmic energy. It's a 'trikerato' (three horns) with a height of approximately 20 meters. It is believed that such sites were used for charging the energy (holy spaces and sacred oracles) and are considered having healing and rejuvenating powers.

## KORNOS The Village of the Red Clay

The picturesque village of Kornos is built upon hilly grounds between Nicosia, Limassol and Larnaca, at an altitude of 320 meters above sea

level. It is set among pines, cypress, eucalyptus, acacia, terebinths, mastic trees, olive trees and wildflowers. The area is ideal for cycling and trekking excursions. Kornos is especially known since ancient times for its pottery craft, the reputation of which has surpassed the borders of Cyprus and receives world-wide recognition. In the village there are ancient remains showing that it was inhabited since antiquity. Ali Bey, the Spanish Domingo, who

visited the village in 1806, writes: I could not obtain any information about the origin of the village. It must be old. It may contain thirty houses at the most. Its position is very pleasant, in the midst of a small valley ridden with olive and locust trees. Almost all the inhabitants are occupied with pottery. The surrounding mountains are covered with cypress trees that grow in dense tufts here and there.

He painted the monastery of St. Ignatius in Ayios Minas, Vavla and many others. His icons are of Byzantine style and he uses traditional egg tempera paint and gold leaf. He also uses the 'fresco' technique on walls. He participated in several tourism fairs both in Europe and Cyprus in cooperation with the Cyprus Tourism Organisation.

#### Constantinos Christou Mosaic Art

At the beginning he was trained by the monk Father Kallinikos (from Stavrovouni), then by his father Christos Steliou, an icon painter, and later by the famous Cypriot mosaic artist Giorgos Kepolas. He started working in churches and the Archbishopric of Cyprus in 1994. His work is now found all over Cyprus, U.K. and the U.S.A. The mosaics are made in the traditional way of enamel and gold (as in Constantinople) and with natural stones which are cut to create mosaics of Byzantine style icons or other historical images. He participated in Cypriot and European fairs in cooperation with the Archbishopric of Cyprus and the Cyprus Tourism Organisation.
